DATA CONTROLLER

PURPOSE OF THE TREATMENT OF DATA

Data associated with this web service are only treated by ICT internal personnel or by external personnel in charge of maintenance activities.

Personal data supplied by visitors of the site is only used in order to fulfill the user requests for services; they are only shared with third parties if required in order to provide these services.

HANDLING OF DATA

The data submitted by users are handled by automated tools as needed to fulfil the purpose of the submission.

Specific security processes and tools are employed to minimize the risk of data loss, unauthorized access or illegal usage of the data.

The Data Controller will not transmit personal data to indeterminate subjects.

Processed data will not be moved to any foreign location.

CATEGORIES OF PROCESSED DATA

NAVIGATION DATA

The IT systems and the software procedures set up for the running of this website acquire, during their normal functioning, some personal data, the transmission of which is an inherent feature of Internet communication protocols. Such information is not collected in order to relate it to identified data subjects, albeit for its own nature it might allow user identification.

This data category includes IP addresses or the domain names of the computers used by any user connecting with this web site, the addresses in URI notation, the time of such requests, the method used for submitting a request to the server, the returning file size, a numerical code indicating the status of server response, and other parameters related to the user's operating system and computer environment.

These data could be used only in order to extract anonymous statistical information on website use and to check its correct running and they are erased immediately after being processed. The data might be used to establish liability in case computer crimes are committed against the website; except for this circumstance, all data regarding web contacts are retained for no longer than seven days.

DATA PROVIDED BY USER

Sending e-mail messages or other data using the forms in this website or using the addresses mentioned on this website, which is done on the basis of a freely chosen, explicit, and voluntary option, entails acquisition of the sender's address, which is necessary in order to reply to any request, as well as of such additional personal data as is contained in the message and its attachments.

COOKIES

No cookies are used to transmit personal information; also, no use is made of the so-called persistent cookies, i.e. systems to trace users.

The so-called session cookies disappear when closing the browser and their use is exclusively limited to the transmission of session ID's necessary to allow the website navigation

DATA PROCESSING ARRANGEMENTS

Personal data are processed with automated tools for a period strictly necessary to achieve the purposes to which they have been collected.

Specific security measures are implemented to prevent loss of data, unlawful and/or inappropriate uses, and accesses without authorization.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTIES

Subjects to whom data refer are entitled at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence of personal data and be informed of their contents and origin, verify their accuracy, or request integration or updating or correction (Art 7 of Leg. Decree. n. 196/2003).

The same Article also provides for the right to request cancellation, or change in anonymous form or blocking of any data that is processed in breach of the law as well as to object in all cases, on rightful grounds, to the data processing.
